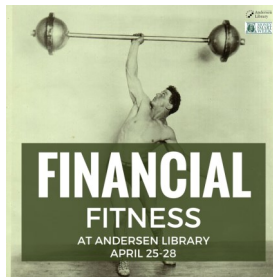
Financial Fitness @ Andersen Library

Join us in sight-reading chamber music in the Andersen Library.

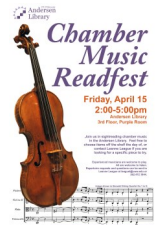
Feel free to choose items off the shelf the day of, or contact Leanne League if you are looking for a specific piece to try.

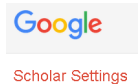
