## Collection Relocations

A large carpeting project will soon be underway on the Library's main floor. To make way for the new flooring, we have temporarily relocated the Browsing and Reference Collections.

The **Reference Collection** has relocated to the end of the Main Collection stacks on the third floor.

The **Browsing Collections**, including New Arrivals, are now all located behind the Reference Desk, where the Reference Collection had been housed.



## Teaching/Learning Spaces

Reference & Instruction librarians are always available to provide library instruction for your students in the Library or in your classroom.

But you can also book Library spaces for Research Days or for your own Library sessions.

Librarian-led sessions have priority for our spaces, but if there are openings, especially in the latter part of the semester, we will allow faculty and instructors to book our teaching spaces.

We have three teaching spaces:

- ◆ **The Library Instruction Lab** has 31 student computers and 1 instructor workstation and projection.
- ◆ **The First Floor Classroom** has an instructor station, 3 projectors/screens, 9 desktops and 15 laptops.
- ◆ **The Children's Curriculum Collection Area** has a SmartBoard and small tables for students.
