
## Goodbye, Sue

## America's Newspapers

When you're looking for the latest news, you probably have a favorite news source, whether online or in print. But the Library needs to offer its users a variety of newspapers and news sources in order to provide a well-balanced view of local, national and world news.

When the *Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel* and *Chicago Tribune* withdrew their content from *LexisNexis* and EBSCO *Newspaper Source Plus* last year, we had to find another source that carried these important regional papers. NewsBank's *America's Newspapers* database offers these two newspapers as well as 1,500 other local and national newspapers from the U.S. and its territories as well as news magazines and local television news stations (video footage).

The Library now has a subscription to [America's Newspapers](#) and is pleased with its local and national coverage of news.

We still have [LexisNexis](#), which is great for international newspapers and [Newspaper Source Plus](#) (EBSCO). [Ethnic Newswatch](#) (ProQuest) offers news from ethnic newspapers across the country.
