## Remote Access to Library via VPN

If you access Library resources from an off-campus computer that has a security firewall, the Library's proxy server may not allow you to login to the Library's databases.

The Library is fortunate to have two superb legal research tools: *LexisNexis Academic* and *WestLaw Campus Research*, which we've recently upgraded to the [WestlawNext](#) interface. The new version will make legal research a little easier for our users.
