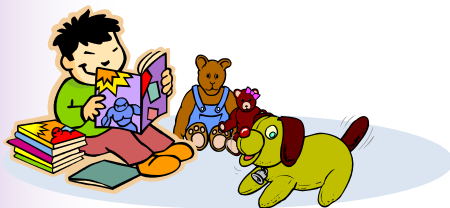

If you're planning to show a video in class, the Video Booking service will ensure the Andersen Library video is available for you on a specific date.



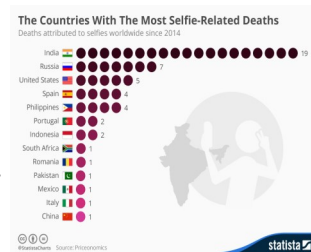
Just fill out the online [Video Booking](#) form and we'll have the DVD ready for you when you need it.

Data and infographics are downloadable in a variety of formats and many images have embed codes so you can easily add them to web pages.

Another great resources is [Data-Planet Statistical Datasets](#), which comes to us courtesy of UW-Madison. It offers 19 billion datapoints from 70 source organizations. Data is presented in charts, maps, graphics and tables.

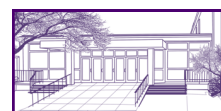
