Easy URLs for Films on Demand

If you use *Films on Demand* in your classes, this news is for you. *Films on Demand* now includes the Library's proxy coding in its URLs, making it easier than ever to embed the links into D2L.



Once you have found the film or segment you want to add to D2L, look **beneath the film window** to find the box labeled "**Title URL**" or "**Segment URL**." This will contain the URL to embed into D2L that will work both on- and off-campus. Off-campus users will be prompted to login to the Library's proxy server to gain access.

If you or your students have trouble streaming *Films on Demand* (it can be slow at times), you can change to a lower resolution for the film to make it stream more easily. See the *Films on Demand Guide* to learn how:

VPN for Login Problems

If you access Library resources from an off-campus computer that has a security firewall, the Library's proxy server won't work and therefore you can't login to the databases.

VPN gives off-campus users another option for logging into the campus network. This technology will allow you to bypass the Library's proxy server. From off-campus locations, go to <http://vpn.uww.edu/> to login using your netID and password.


Scholastic Book Sale
