Journal Citation Reports

Before the Library subscribed to [Journal Citation Reports \(JCR\)](#), we had many faculty inquiries about it.

JCR is one of the standard ways to measure the importance of journals within a discipline in the sciences and social sciences. By tracking citations to recent articles in a journal and comparing it to the total number of articles published in that journal, JCR calculates the "impact factor" of the journal. Impact factors are calculated each year. **Journal Citation Reports®**

The renowned *New England Journal of Medicine*, for instance, has an impact factor of **50.807** for 2012 while *Lancet*, the prestigious British medical journal, has a lesser (but still very high) impact factor of **36.427**.

Cabell's Publishing Opportunities



The [Cabell's Directory of Publishing Opportunities](#) is a handy tool for faculty seeking journals in which to publish their work.

The online version of Cabell's allows searching by subject, journal title, publisher, acceptance rates, type of review (e.g., double-blind), and fees. Although the directories cover mainly business, education, psychology/psychiatry, and computer-science disciplines, journals in many other fields are included.

To see if a specific journal is included, use the "List of all Journals in our Directories." Then select the directory in which the journal appears to get more information on that journal.
