The [eBook Academic Collection](#) from EBSCOhost offers more than 113,000 ebooks in a wide range of subject areas from scholarly and association publishers worldwide.

Signing up for a *My EBSCOhost* account (once you're logged into EBSCO), allows users to download ebooks to a smart device, ebook reader or computer. Otherwise, books can be read online.

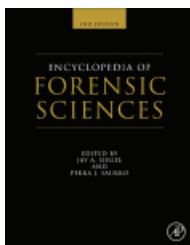


Feature film DVDs, graphic novels, children's books, games, flip camcorders and iPads are just some of the material we'll highlight at this year's Fair.

Wiley Online Library eBooks

This year the UW System is conducting a pilot ebook project using the [Wiley Online Library](#). The pilot gives us full access to all the books in the Wiley Online Library for the year (excludes reference books).

The pilot is a patron-driven model, so we'll purchase titles based on what was used during the trial. We already own several thousand of these books based on our subscription to the 1,200 Wiley journals included in the [Wiley Online Library](#). The journal package was originally negotiated with UW-Madison and the CIC (Committee on Institutional Cooperation).

Our users downloaded more than 8,000 journal articles from the Wiley Online Library last year and we hope the ebooks will be equally useful.
