

## Policy Governing Use of the Andersen Library Large-Screen Television

Andersen Library's large-screen television is intended to be used for educational, informational, and recreational purposes serving the University community.

News is displayed as a default. Other broadcast/cable channels or recorded material may be displayed as part of Library-sponsored programs or by request. Priority is given to academic-related and Library programming. Instructional staff may use this viewing venue for classes by making prior arrangements. The Library reserves the right to deny any request.

- **Requests to display a different broadcast/cable channel** may be made to the Circulation Desk staff. Such requests are approved on a first-come, first-served basis and honored for the length of a specifically requested program.
- **Requests to display recorded material** (DVDs, VHS recordings, Blu-Ray discs) require approval by the Library Director or designee and proof of compliance with copyright restrictions. Individual viewing of Library materials does not require copyright clearance.
