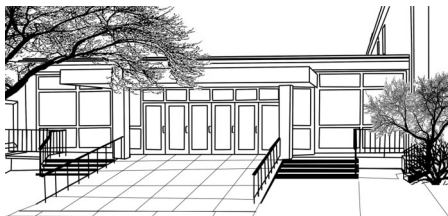

### Librarians Make House Calls

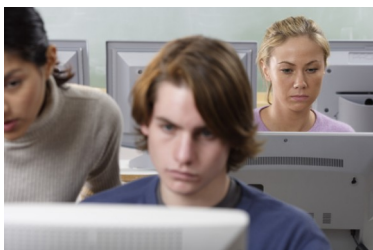
